Beginning and duration

The summer camp will start its activities on Monday, June 27, 2011 to terminate on Friday, September 2, 2011, a duration of 10 consecutive weeks.

Opening hours

The summer day camp operates Monday to Friday, from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. The camp will not operate Thursday, July 1 and Monday, August 1, these being legal holidays.

Administration fees

An administration fee of \$ 50 is required for each recording week at camp "Au p'tit monde franco inc. If the child comes to camp, the fee of \$ 50 will be delivered again to the parent.

Payment methods
